## Tipster with Troy Koepke tip asked to contact Crime Stoppers

TOPEKA, Kan. – More than 27 years after he was shot and killed outside a Topeka bank, Shawnee County Crime Stoppers received a tip in the 1993 Cold Case homicide of Troy A. Koepke.

Crime Stoppers is wanting to speak anonymously with the tipster who law enforcement believes may have important information about the case. Crime Stoppers is asking the tipster to call them at 785-234-0007, communicate with them through their secure website or the P3 Tips App.

Koepke, who was 25 at the time of his death, had left work at the former Sirloin Stockade located at 1251 SW Ashworth Place in Topeka and was preparing to deposit the night's receipts at the Fidelity State Bank located at 5926 SW 21<sup>st</sup> St.

On March 21, 1993 at around 4:30 a.m. Topeka Police Officers found Koepke deceased in his car outside the bank. Koepke is believed to have been shot and killed at around 2:00 a.m. on March 21.

Police believe that one or more people with ties to Osage County, Kansas may have information about this case.

Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$2,000 reward for information that leads to an arrest in this case.
