What is cyberbullying?

Cyberbullying is the use of

electronic communication to bully a person, typically by sending messages of an intimidating or threatening nature.

What should I do if I am being

cyberbullied?

You should talk to a trusted adult as soon as possible. You can also report anonymously to the Crimestoppers Safe School App.

Is cyberbullying against the law?

Cyberbullying is **ILLEGAL** in

Louisiana. Penalties can include up between \$500-\$5,000 in fines. Jail time of up to 6 months to 1 year.

What is a bystander?

If you see it happening online or in person that makes you a bystander. You can ask the bully to stop. You can tell a trusted adult. You can report anonymously to the Crimestoppers Safe School App. Please speak up! If you don't say anything. The bullying won't stop.
