Louisiana summers are ALWAYS hot. Make sure to do the following:

- Drink plenty of water.
- Wear protective gear such as hats, sunscreen, glasses, etc.
- Avoid direct sunlight between 11a.m.—3p.m. when it is the hottest.

Safety reaches far beyond summer heat. While exploring this summer remember to do the following:

- Never explore alone always have a friend, group of friends, or trusted adult with you.
- Never give out personal information or inappropriate information about you or family members online.
- If you ever feel unsafe or uncomfortable tell a trusted adult as soon as possible.



How to play I Spy?

- You should "spy" an item that is currently in plain view <u>NOT</u> something that has passed and no longer visible.
- Use descriptive words for example: I spy something red, tall, square, etc.
- Have the others guess what the item, person, or thing maybe "Is it a ball, chair, tv, etc.?
- Leader can only answer yes or no.
- The person who has guessed what the leader has in mind has won the game and now becomes the leader.

An example round:

Leader: I spy something square.

Player 1: Is it the carpet?

Leader: No.

Player 2: Is it the T.V.

Leader: Yes.

Now, Player 2 becomes the leader
