Instructions Coastal Bend Crime Stoppers Scholarship

Bee County Goliad County Live Oak County

Criteria for Eligibility:

- 1. Must be a recent graduate of a high school in Bee, Goliad, or Live Oak County.
- 2. One scholarship per county will be offered to qualifying students in each of the three counties; however, if there is not a qualifying student in a county that scholarship can go to a qualifying student in one of the other two counties.
- 3. Another scholarship sponsored by the Bee County Sheriff's Office in memory of Sheriff Carlos Carrizales, Jr. will be offered to a qualifying student in Bee County.
- 4. Must attend a junior/community college or 4-year college/university majoring in law enforcement/criminal justice <u>OR</u> be the son/daughter/grandchild of an active/retired Texas commissioned peace officer. (Majoring in any field)
- Completed applications and essays will be submitted to Crime Stoppers by mail to:

Procedures – Student

- 1. Submit completed application with essay.
- 2. Submit current transcript showing class rank and GPA.
- 3. Typed (neatly handwritten excepted) essay shall include:
 - (1) a detailed description of services rendered at school and in community and
 - (2) explanation as to why applicant is applying for this scholarship (explain need for financial aid) and explain why they chose their field of study.
- 4. Submit application, essay, and transcript by specified time.

Procedures for Award:

- 1. The Coastal Bend Crime Stoppers directors shall make the final selection of the recipient of the scholarships.
- 2. In the event there are no qualifying applicants for the scholarships, the scholarships will not be given out. If there is no qualifying applicant for a county, it can go to a qualifying student in one of the other two counties. If there is not a qualifying applicant for the scholarship offered by the Bee County Sheriff's Office that scholarship will not be awarded.

Payment of Scholarship:

- 1. One half of the scholarship funds will be awarded in the Fall and one half in the Spring and paid directly to the college/university.
- Each semester student must show proof of enrollment (bill from registrar/schedule
 of classes with Student ID number) and the address of the college/university office
 to whom the funds are to be sent. (Email to coastalbendcs@gmail.com)
