## **DO YOU KNOW THIS PERSON?**

Investigators hoping to identify a pedestrian killed in a recent collision have released a composite sketch of the victim.

The crash happened Wednesday, November 2, 2022, in south Williamson County at the intersection of Amberglen Boulevard and W. Parmer Lane.

The Department of Public Safety says the woman was hit at around 6:40 a.m. She appears to be homeless in her early 20s, 5'9", 190lbs, with no tattoos, piercings, or distinguishing physical characteristics.

Investigators believe she had recent laparoscopic surgery on her gallbladder, possibly within the last few weeks, as the incisions had not fully healed.
